If you intend to photocopy or scan from books, it's likely you'll need a Copyright Licensing print licence. For around the cost of one new book per classroom your school can maximise existing print resources and enable your teachers to enjoy worry-free copying.

A Copyright Licensing print licence enables teachers to:

Photocopy and scan

- ✓ 10% of books (including pictures and graphs)
- ✓ 15 pages from short story and poetry books
- ✓ Complete journal and newspaper articles

Share with students via

- ✓ Printed handouts
- ✓ Electronic whiteboard
- ✓ Intranet

A OneMusic licence enables schools to:

- ✓ Perform music at assemblies, concerts and social events
- ✓ Photocopy sheet music
(For print musical works, up to 30 copies for every original owned and for choral works up to 5 copies for every original owned.)
- ✓ Make recordings of performances available to students and their families
- ✓ Create and make digital music files for use in lessons
- ✓ Stream recorded events from your website

- ✓ Download AV material legally online, including podcasts and vodcasts
- ✓ Access more online resources including eTV and Clickview
